Happy New Year everybody! We're going to kick this New Year off with our **Annual Meeting**, quickly followed by the **Huntsville Boat Show**. According to our Bylaws, we hold our Election of Officers during our Annual Meeting. Dick Raymont sent everyone the Slate of Officers a few weeks ago, so you should have received it. But we'll go over all of that at the meeting on Monday, 13 January. The Annual Meeting is a pretty important event each year, so I hope you can make it. We realize that's the night of the BCS College Football Championship, but that's the best date we could find.

Both of these events are coming up very soon, so please read our Administrative Officer's article in this newsletter so you can see the details of place and time, etc. I've included the Boat Show "manning roster" below so you can see what time slot you signed up for, and for those who haven't signed up yet, you can see which time slots are open. This is voluntary, so pick a time you're comfortable with and we'll see you there. We'll discuss Boat Show details at the Annual Meeting and you can sign up then.

Boat Operator Certification (BOC) School

In addition to being your Commander, I'm also the District 17 Boat Operator Certification Director. As such, I'd like to announce a very special BOC event that's coming up in March that you might be interested in.

The United States Power Squadrons will provide a BOC School for members who are in the BOC Mid-South Region. Since the Mid-South Region includes, District 17, any members in the America's Boating Club of North Alabama (Huntsville Sail and Power Squadron) are eligible to participate. So if you've been waiting for a chance to get involved in BOC, this is the best chance you'll have for quite some time. Here are the details as I know them so far.

- BOC Levels: Inland Navigator (IN), Coastal Navigator (CN), Advanced Coastal Navigator (ACN), and Offshore Navigator (ON)
- BOC School Dates: March 26th to 29th 2020
- BOC School Location: Pensacola, Florida
- How to Sign Up: Contact Tom Hamilton via Email: <u>Bmc3i@yahoo.com</u>, or call (256) 508-3092.
 Once I have a list of those interested, I will provide everyone the information they need. Please respond to me soon if you're interested.
- Cost: This will depend on how much you plan to accomplish during the School. If you're just getting started, you'll want to complete the on-water skills for the first one or two levels (Inland Navigator then Coastal Navigator). To do so, you'll need to order a "BOC Passport" for each of those levels. A BOC Passport costs \$50 and can be ordered by contacting our Educational Officer, Chris Whitacre.

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- Where to stay: There is a Holiday Inn Express in the Pensacola area that has been contacted to block rooms at a given rate. The specific rate has not yet been announced but it should be quite affordable.
- Deadline to sign up: February 1st 2020

So if you're interested, or even if you think you might be interested, email me so I can add you to my list of participants. You can make up your mind after we talk it over. This type of opportunity to get a head start in BOC does not come around often.
